### Fire Report Milford Township Fire Association

The Milford Township Fire Department currently has 26 members with over 270 years of experience. We meet twice a month..... the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month, alternating between Collinsville and Darrtown. At these meetings, we check equipment and do training to stay up to date with the equipment. The officers have one additional meeting to plan and receive updates from the chief. If you are interested in becoming a volunteer, see any firefighter or stop by at one of our meetings.

The annual **Spaghetti Dinner is set for Saturday April 9<sup>th</sup>**, at the Community Center in Collinsville. We start serving a 4:00pm. Again this year, we have raffles, split the pot, and a 50 inch flat screen TV will be raffled. This has turned into a community event, so please come out and visit with your neighbors and support your fire department.

This November, our fire levy is up for renewal. This will not raise your taxes, since it is a renewal of the current levy. These monies go to pay for Life Squad, as well as covering the cost of new trucks and equipment for the fire department.

We are currently getting information so that we can replace our two current grass fire trucks. The Darrtown truck is a 1983 model and the Collinsville truck is a 1990. They have served us well but it is time to upgrade these units. We hope to have the new trucks in service later this year.


